Grounds: The Hunt Test grounds are located west of Bernardo, New Mexico. Bernardo is between Belen and Socorro on **Interstate 25 at Exit 175**. Take the **Exit 175** ramp to Kiva RV Park on the west side of I-25 and continue south on the access road for 1.5 miles, then at the **T** intersection, turn right (West) on the dirt road and continue for 7.2 miles. Turn right immediately after crossing the cattle guard. From cattle guard proceed 0.7 miles to the Field Trial camp grounds.

NOTICE: ALWAYS KEEP THE GATE CLOSED OFF THE MAIN DIRT ROAD.

BIG RIGS: Please be careful turning at the cattle guard.

Camping: Camping will be allowed in designated areas on the Hunt test Grounds. The designated area is just south of the abandoned wind mill structure and just east of the western enclosure fence for the property. Please carry off all of your trash. Toilet facilities will be provided. You are responsible for providing water for dogs and humans. **NO WATER WAGON WILL BE PROVIDED.** Please bring drinking water for yourself, your dogs, and your horses.

Food: CNMBC will NOT provide food or water. Please bring your own.

Hotels: Belen, NM is about 20 minutes north and Socorro is about 25 minutes south of the Field Trial grounds, or Kiva RV Park and Horse Motel (505-861-0693)
